

# How to Separate and Put Out Garbage

## MORIOKA AREA

### < Garbage to be put out at the collection point >

TYPES	CONTENTS	PREPARATION FOR DISPOSAL
BURNABLE	kitchen garbage, paper, woodchips, rubber, cloth, leather, soft plastic	Put your garbage in a transparent bag. Carpets and mattresses must be folded less than 1 meter and tied. Drain the garbage well.
NON-BURNABLE	ceramics, glass, metal objects, small electrical products(micro waves,etc.), hard plastics, foam polystyrene	Put your garbage in a transparent plastic bag. Empty the bottles and cans of oil or paint. Remove the batteries before putting out.
RECYCLABLE	glass bottles cans, spray cans plastic (PET) bottles	Put the glass bottles, cans and PET bottles in separate transparent bags. Remove the caps from the bottles / PET bottles. Put out the caps as non-burnable garbage. Rinse the inside with water. Use up the content of a spray can and punch a hole on it.
	used newspaper	Don't put them in any bags. Put out unclean ones as burnable garbage. Remove plastic and other non-paper materials beforehand. Put out waterproofed boxes or ones with gold or silver paper pasted on them as burnable garbage.

### < Garbage not to be put out at the collection point >

TYPES	CONTENTS	PREPARATION FOR DISPOSAL
LARGE SIZE	bicycles, furniture, microwaves, defumidifiers, other home appliances.	1) Call Recycling Promotion Division to apply for collection. (Up to Three items at one time.) 2) You need to pay ¥600 per item. Buy a collection ticket and stick it on the prominent part of the garbage. Stick two tickets on a garbage whose width, depth or height is two meters or longer.
Items required to be recycled	FOUR SPECIFIED HOME APPLIANCES(air conditioners, TV's, refrigerators / freezers, washing machines and combos.)	Ask the store where you bought it for collection or recycling manufacture for disposal (You need to pay)
	PC's	Ask the manufacture for recycling.
SPECIFIC/ DANGEROUS	motorbikes, compressed gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, tires, car batteries, auto parts, etc.	Ask the store where you bought it or a waste disposer for disposal.(You might have to pay)
	rechargeable batteries, button-type batteries.	Put them in the collection box in an electric appliances store.
	dead animals	Ask a pet funeral business or take it to Mitsuwari or Kado Control Station of Collection Trucks. (you need to pay)
	Non-burnable animal-waste treatment agent	Take it to a Recycling Center or ask a garbage collection trader for disposal.
	used dry cell batteries,fluorescent tubes	Put them in the collection box in a supermarket

※ Different districts have different collection days. The garbage collecting schedule is given in the Gomi Shushu Calender.

Put your garbage at the designated place by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.

TONAN AREA		
TYPES	CONTENTS	PREPARATION FOR DISPOSAL
KITCHEN GARBAGE	leftover food, disposed foodstuff	Drain the garbage well. Put it into the container placed at the designated place. Take your container home.
BURNABLE	paper, wood chips, clothes, plastic products, rubber, leather	Put it in a see through bag.
RECYCLABLE	empty glass bottles and cans	Put it in a see through bag.
	used paper (newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes), paper cartons, used clothes, plastic (PET) bottles	Tie newspapers, magazines and cardboard boxes separately. Paper carton should be made 100% from paper. Used clothes should be wasted beforehand. Remove the caps from PET bottles. Put out the caps as burnable garbage.
LARGE SIZE / NON-BURNABLE	large-sized garbage (large furniture, bikes, etc.), daily-use products, kitchen utensils	Tell the Seiso Center about the items that can still be used. Put the daily-use articles in a bag.
FOUR SPECIFIED HOME APPLIANCES	Same as Morioka Area	Take dead animals to the Seiso Center. Put the used dry cell batteries in the collecting box at the designated place. Put out the pet-waste treatment agent as burnable garbage.

Put your garbage at the designated place by 8:00 a.m. on the collecting day.

## TAMAYAMA- KU

### <Garbage to be put out at the collection point>

TYPES	CONTENTS	PREPARATION FOR DISPOSAL
BURNABLE	kitchen garbage, waste paper, wood-chips, cloth, foam polystyrene	Dry branches/twigs and cut them 5cm or less in diameter, 50 cm or less in length. Items over 50cm or longer are collected on large-size garbage day.
NON-BURNABLE	ceramics, glass, metal objects, small home appliances, small furniture	Small home appliances are roughly 50cm or smaller.
RECYCLABLE	glass bottles, cans, plastic (PET) bottles	Bottles, cans and PET bottles should be put in separate transparent bags. Rinse the inside with water. Remove the lid and put out a plastic lid as burnable.
	newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes, paper cartons, white Styrofoam food tray	Strap the newspapers, magazines, cardboards and paper cartons crosswise separately. Put white food trays in a transparent bag.
LARGE SIZE	bikes, large furniture, large home appliances, mattresses/bed quilts, blankets, carpets	Remove batteries. Remove springs from sofas and beds.
DANGEROUS / HARMFUL	lighters, spray cans, gas bottle, fluorescent lamp, dry batteries	Punch spray cans and gas bottles. Use up lighters.

### <Garbage not to be put out at the collection point>

TYPES	CONTENTS	PREPARATION FOR DISPOSAL
SHOULD BE RECYCLED	air conditioners, TV's, refrigerators, washing machines, PC's	Ask the store where you bought it for collection or waste disposal services for disposal (You are charged.) Ask the manufacturer for recycle of your PC.
DANGEROUS / HARD TO DISPOSE OF	motorbikes, compressed gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, tires, batteries, etc.	Take them to the store where you bought them or to a waste disposal service and ask for disposal (Some services charge you.) Fire extinguishers and car batteries can be brought in to Iwate Tamayama Seiso Jigyosho (phone:682-0552.) : ¥500 per unit.

※ Collection days are scheduled differently for each neighborhood. Find the schedule for your neighborhood in the "Tamayamakunai Gyoji Calendar", or on the website of Morioka City. (<http://www.city.morioka.iwate.jp>)

Put out your garbage at the collection point designated in your neighborhood by 8.30 am of collection days.

Put the garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent plastic bag.
